

TIMELINE PROCESS OF LSBU SUMMER SCHOOL 2025

Stage 1 – Grade Average Price

Once your application has been submitted, you'll receive an email within 2 working days. Confirming your Grade Average on the SRS for the three previous semesters. The faculty will select and inform students by end of day 21st February 2025.

Stage 2 –Deposit Payment (50,000 Egyptian Pounds)

Deadline: Payment due on **Sunday 9th March 2025**

Email: [studyabroad@bue.edu.eg] a copy of your passport and a receipt of your deposit in Egyptian pounds already made to the University treasury office in building E first floor using your BUE ID.

Stage 3 – Week beginning 23rd March - Visa Application on Campus (£115)

You'll need to complete the UK Visa Application on campus. Further information will be provided in due course. You will need to pay the £115 at the time of the online visa application; therefore, you must bring a credit card which will allow you to complete the payment online during the visa application process.

Stage 4 – In Person Appointment at Visa Application Centre

Once your UK Visa Application has been submitted online, you'll schedule an in-person appointment at the TLS UK Visa Office.

Stage 5 – Pay remaining 2nd Instalment (in GBP £ or equivalent in USD)

Deadline: Payment due on **Thursday 13th April 2025**

Ensure to read the important notes on the next page before submitting an application

Important notes:

1. You must have a valid passport with an expiry date after **28th February 2026**, if not you should apply for a new passport immediately. Validation must include Aman Medical Insurance on the last page of your passport. If you do not have this, you must visit the Passport's Office in Abbasiya.
2. Please make sure the name on your Passport is spelt the exact same as your BUE Student ID on the SRS, this is important for the UK Visa Application process.
3. All students must settle all their dues by the deadline for the deposit payment (9th March 2025). Kindly check your SRS account – Financial Statement.
4. Payments for the trip will not be approved without completing the online application form and formally agreeing to the Terms & Conditions.
5. The Summer School Subject-Specific Programme must have a minimum of 10 students per department to go ahead. Failure to meet the minimum requirement will result in cancellation. Students may opt onto the generic program instead.
