Modules descriptions:

Semester 1
PSYGR01 Research Methods and Advanced Statistics in Psychology
This module introduces more advanced research methods, especially details of different experimental designs, considerations of sample size, and effect size. The module guides students to advanced statistical techniques such as multivariate analysis, some structural equation modelling techniques, and/or factor analysis. A main focus of the course is how to develop sensible research questions and how to choose the appropriate statistical techniques to answer these questions.
PSYCP01 Clinical Psychology: An Advanced Introduction
This module provides an in-depth treatment of basic aspects of clinical Psychology, and its main issues in diagnosis and treatment. It also addresses contemporary controversial issues in the field.
PSYCP02 Psychopathology
This module provides an in-depth treatment of psychopathological theory of different psychological disorders and recent developments in the field from psychological, social, and biological perspectives.
PSYCP03 Clinical Psychiatry
This module provides an in-depth treatment of the psychiatric approach to mental disorders, and it addresses the relationship between the psychologists and the psychiatrists and other members in the therapeutic team
Semester 2
PSYGR 02 Models and System of Psychology
This module covers basic trends of the history of psychology and the major traditional approaches to psychology (e.g., gestalt, behavioral, psychoanalytic, humanistic, cognitive approaches) and their philosophical underpinnings.
PSYCP04 Psychotherapy
This module covers the basic aspects and approaches of the psychotherapeutic process. Also, it emphasizes different therapeutic techniques in their relation to their theoretical origins and their implicit assumption about human nature.
PSYCP05 Cognitive & Dialectical Behavioural Therapy
This module covers basic aspects, theoretical bases, and different techniques of cognitive behavioral therapy. The module includes practical training as part of the practicum.
PSYCP06 Group Therapy
This module covers basic aspects, theoretical bases, and different techniques of group therapy. The module includes practical training as part of the practicum.
Semester 3
PSYCP07 Thesis

During this semester, the student and his/her advisor are supposed to finalize the student's prospectus, and the student should start working on its implementation.

Semester 4

PSYCP08 Thesis

By the end of the semester, the student should have the main bulk of the data s/he needs and finalize writing his/her thesis. Evaluation is Pass/Fail.
