Number of Active mobilities:

- **University of Gdańsk (Poland):** 3 staff mobilities under the *Training Mobility on International Cooperation* programme.
- **Ludovika University of Public Service (Hungary):** Erasmus+ collaboration (mobility postponed to AY 2026–2027).
- **University of Economics in Katowice (Poland):** 7 student and 15 staff mobilities, with 4 outgoing participants in Spring 2026.
- **Constantine the Philosopher University in Nitra (Slovakia):** 1 student, 12 staff, and 1 outgoing mobility, totaling 14 mobilities in *Marketing & Media*.
- **Budapest Metropolitan University (Hungary):** 1 student and 2 staff mobilities, totaling 3 mobilities in *Marketing & Media*.
