



## The COP27 Simulation Model

The British University in Egypt organized the **COP27 Simulation** Model in collaboration with the UNDP and under the auspices of H.E. Dr. Ashraf Sobhy, the Minister of Youth and Sports, H.E. Professor Mohamed Ayman Ashour, the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, and H.E. Professor Mahmoud Mohieldin the UN High-Level Climate Champion.

The **COP27 Simulation** brought together around 130 students from around the world to simulate the COP27 in an international conference that will be hosted on campus at the British University in Egypt during the period 18-20 October 2022. Participants presented and voted for policy proposals and develop a climate statement that will be presented in the real COP27. The outcomes of the **COP27 Simulation** are presented at COY17, included into the Global Youth Statement issued by Youth constituency to United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (YOUNGO) and will be presented at COP27 in two sessions in the Green Zone and Blue Zone on November 10<sup>th</sup>.
